SPIRE is an Orton-Gillingham based reading intervention program for the lowest level readers and students with Dyslexia or those who show signs of Dyslexia. It includes explicit, teacher-led instruction. The consistent 10-step lessons are systematic and sequentially structured to ensure mastery of concepts and allow for easy implementation. It incorporates multisensory learning – auditory, visual and kinesthetic activities keep students engaged. The program includes mastery of concepts – data-driven instruction with continual practice and review which ensures measurable and permanent gains. Available in print, grades PK-8, or digital (iSPIRE), grades 1-6.
